

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE UNREASONABLE ACCELERATION OF MOTOR VEHICLES AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DANUBE, MN, DOES HEREBY ORDAIN:

Section 1. UNREASONABLE ACCELERATION

No person shall start or accelerate any motor vehicle with an unnecessary exhibition of speed on any public or private way within the City of Danube. Prima-facie evidence of such unnecessary exhibition of speed shall be squealing or screeching sounds emitted by the tires or the throwing of sand or gravel by the tires of said vehicle; or the swerving of the rear of the automobile from side to side.

Section 2. PENALTY

Any violation of this ordinance shall constitute a "petty misdemeanor" as defined in the Statutes of the State of Minnesota, and shall provide for a sentence or a fine of not more than \$100.
