

ORDINANCE NO. 62

DANUBE FIREWOOD

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DANUBE, MN. ESTABLISHING A SHADE TREE PROGRAM, PROVIDING REGULATION FOR THE CONTROL OF CERTAIN DISEASES AFFECTING TREES. INCORPORATING AGENCY RULES AND REGULATIONS, AND PROVIDING FOR PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

The City Council of the City of Danube, MN. ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. REGULATIONS ADOPTED BY REFERENCE; Section 1,0109 through 1,0111 of 3 Minnesota Code of Agency Rules, Department of Agriculture, Shade Tree Program (1978 Edition) together with amendments thereof to date, are hereby adopted by reference and made a part of this ordinance as if set out in full, except as herein after provided. A copy of said agency rules herewith incorporated is on file in the City of Danube.

SECTION 2. The stockpiling of bark bearing elm wood within the City Limits of the City of Danube shall be permitted during the period from Sept. 15 through April 1 of any given year. Any such wood not utilized by April 1 of any year must then be removed and disposed of as provided by this ordinance and the regulations incorporated thereby.

SECTION 3. Where the provisions of this ordinance conflicts or are inconsistent with any other ordinance of the City, the provisions of this ordinance shall supersede except in instances where one regulation is more restrictive than another in which case the more restrictive shall apply and control.

SECTION 4. Any person who shall violate any provisions of ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be deemed guilty of misdemeanor, and shall be subject to a fine of not to exceed \$500, or imprisonment of not to exceed 90 days, or both.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall become effective upon its due passage and enactment and publication according to law.
