

CITY OF DANUBE RESOLUTION # 1998-1

**An resolution amending Danube City Ordinance # 88**

The City council of the city of Danube, Minnesota, does ordain that Section 9 of Danube City Ordinance No. 88 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 9.     **Restrictions on Purchase and Consumption.**

Subd. 1.     **Liquor in unlicensed places.** No person shall mix or prepare liquor for consumption in any public place or place of business unless it has a license to sell liquor "on-sale".

Subd. 2.     **Consumption in public places.** No person shall consume liquor on a public highway, public park, or other public place, except as such consumption is authorized by:


- A.     The terms of a Temporary On-Sale or On-Sale License issued under this Ordinance, or
- B.     Minnesota Statute Section 340A.404, Subdivision 4

provided such possession or consumption does not violate other provisions of Minnesota Statutes Chapter 340A, as now in effect or hereafter amended.

All other provisions of Danube City Ordinance #88, are re-affirmed and ratified in their entirety.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and publication as required by law.
