

**DANUBE CITY COUNCIL
Emergency Council Meeting
Thursday, May 11, 2017 8:00 PM
Danube City Council Chambers**

A special meeting of the Danube City Council was conducted on May 11, 2017 at 8:00 p.m. with Mayor Gene Alex presiding.

The following Councilmembers were present: Sharon Krogman, Cathy Malvin, Dave Maurice and Phil Standfuss

Approval of Agenda

Councilmember Maurice moved and Councilmember Standfuss seconded a motion to approve the Agenda. The motion carried unanimously.

Street Sweeper

Councilmember Maurice informed the other Councilmembers that Dan went and looked at the other street sweeper. The street sweeper is a year newer than the one he was looking at from Macqueen. It is a 2006. There is a bent door hinge but Dan is not sure if he will be able to fix that or not. The sweeper has a/c and hydraulics instead of chain drive brushes. It is a series P. They are asking \$28,000.00. Councilmember Krogman asked if the street sweeper had all its brushes. Councilmember Maurice stated that Dan can use the brushes that are on it but it will need brushes next year. The old street sweeper has new brushes on it and those brushes would fit this new street sweeper, they are interchangeable. Councilmember Krogman also asked if we would get any record of repairs or upkeep. Councilmember Maurice stated the guy Dan talked to was kind of an office guy. He didn't run it or know anything about it because it is a lot different than what ours is. Dan is pretty confident that he could talk to the workers in Olivia and possibly Renville who run their street sweeper on tips on how to run this type of street sweeper. Councilmember Maurice also reported that the starter was acting up and Dan would take care of that. Councilmember Standfuss stated that if Dan thinks that this street sweeper will work for him and fits into his public works budget then we should purchase it.

Councilmember Standfuss moved and Councilmember Malvin seconded a motion to approve the purchase of the 2006 street sweeper from Curb to Curb out of Shakopee for \$28,000.00. The motion carried unanimously.

Councilmember Maurice moved and Councilmember Krogman seconded a motion to approve transferring \$30,000.00 from Hometown Bank to Minnwest Bank checking. The motion carried unanimously.

Adjournment

There being no further business before the council, Councilmember Standfuss moved and Councilmember Malvin seconded a motion to adjourn the meeting. With all members voting in favor, the meeting was adjourned at 8:07 p.m.
