

BUILDING PROJECT GETS NOD AT ANNUAL MEETING

The building planning committee of Al Schochenmaier, Stan Malecek and Maurice Schroeder have been busy researching ways to build a multi-functional building for the museum grounds. At the Annual Meeting on April 12, Al and Stan presented a plan to the members in attendance. Their criteria for the plans included a need for a storage area, bathroom and limited use kitchen, with handicapped access and to have a look that would be similar to the depot. They had plans drawn up, and the view from the west side is seen above. Steel wainscoting, a floating slab, and water and sewer, were included in the plans. An overhang on the south side that would cover a serving area for concessions at fall festival and during concerts was also included. This building idea has been talked about for several years, and is now at the point where it will provide everything we had suggested in our "wants list". The location for the building would be where the Legion's Veteran Memorial is currently located. The Veteran Memorial would be moved to the center lawn area vacated by the removal of the old water tower, making it more visible from the road. The size of the building is 28 x 32, plus the 6 foot overhang on the south side. We need to gain approval from the city of Danube for this project before we proceed any further, and the idea will be presented at the May City Council meeting (May 9). We have asked for estimates from a couple of suppliers and carpenters and when we know what things will cost, we will then start fundraising. We will establish a building fund for donations, and we have a fairly healthy balance in our treasury to get started, but we will need your help! We are looking into possible grants, and will have fundraising events in the coming year to finance this project. Please support our efforts wherever you can. Our historical society is working hard (all volunteer) to preserve the local history of Danube, and we hope you feel it is worthwhile, as we do.
