

PUBLIC WORKS REPORT

1. I would like to have someone come in to look at why we are not getting ant heat in the main lobby in the school. I was in the tunnels and it looks like there isn't any air going to the valve on the radiator. It won't operate to allow heat without air. We also have some other rooms where I believe we need some new thermostats. We've always called Honeywell in the past. Was going to see if someone more local can do this since Honeywell isn't cheap. But they know what they are doing.
2. The plow needs to be brought out to Schmolls for some minor repair. The driver side mirror brackets were broke when the plow was being backed in the shop. The Skid plates also need to be replaced to help prevent premature wear on the cutting edge.
3. The new door was installed on the shop. They have to come back and swap out one panel for the right color yet. They ordered wrong color first time. I'm also dealing with them on the opener. It seems to not want to work after the door has been left open for more than 15 seconds. I left the old doors on the building and just bolted the down. Didn't know what the city wants to do with them. They are all metal. Does anybody know anyone who might have a use for them? They will be on there till Spring/Summer when I can get help to remove them.
4. I talked with Steve Chandler from the County. He informed me that they are planning an overlay on CTY RD 1 from the Railroad tracks and going north sometime this summer. He said they also might do some south of that in town where there are some bad

spots. He was wondering if we have any projects coming up on that road so they wouldn't be interfering and so we wouldn't be tearing up new overlay. I told him as of now we do not have any projects planned.

5. I checked into some X-MAS light decorations for the poles. The prices vary from around \$8,000.00 - \$12,000.00 depending on size and style. That is for all 20 decorations. They are \$350.00 - \$500.00 apiece.
6. We had two bad floats in the Lift Station. This was causing the pumps to turn in for five seconds and shut off. This led to a lot of cycling to keep up and could have burned out the pumps. It was also giving incorrect pump calculation data. The floats were replaced by Dakota Pump. Now after seeing what they did I believe I can do this next time and save the city money.
7. The Wells averaged 39,000 gallons per day for the month of December. The Lift Station averaged 41,000 gallons pumped for the month.
